



PARENTS' DAY OUT INFORMATION

WHAT IS PARENTS' DAY OUT?

Parents' Day Out is a supervised, structured play program for children ages 2 through 3 years old. The group meets from 9:30 – 12:00 on most Fridays from late September through mid-May. Children are given the opportunity to play with age appropriate toys, create art projects, play outside on the playground, have a snack, and listen to books. Enrollment is limited to 14 children per session with three adults. It's a great way for children to be able to socialize and practice new skills, and gives parents some free time.

ENROLLMENT

Sign-up begins in September after the start of the preschool year. Enrollment forms are available in the preschool office, along with our website. You may sign up for the whole year or for selected Fridays based on availability. If the program is filled for the day you would like to use, you will be notified that your child is on the waiting list for the day. We will call you if there is an opening.

COST AND PAYMENT POLICY

The cost for Parents' Day Out is \$30 per Friday. Community families also pay a \$25 registration fee. Payment may be made by check, cash, or by credit card using our Brightwheel system (additional fees may apply to credit transactions). If your child is also enrolled in our preschool program, please send separate checks for each payment. The program ends promptly at 12:00. Please note that may be a \$10 late fee if you are more than 10 minutes late in picking up your child. Before and after care are available for additional fees.

CANCELLATION POLICY

When you need to take your child's name off of a Friday list, please notify someone in the preschool office so that we can fill the spot from the waiting list. If you are signed up for a drop-in spot and need to cancel, please let the preschool know in order to avoid paying the \$30 fee.

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

We ask that parents bring in extra diapers (if your child uses them) and a change of clothes in case of accidents. Please dress your child according to the weather as they do go outside to play on most days. Label your child's bags, coats, hats, mittens, etc. as many young children are unable to identify their belongings. We provide a snack and water for the children. If your child has dietary restrictions, please let us know so that we can plan accordingly. We are a nut free school.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Medical forms, including information regarding allergies, are required for each child. Health exclusions can be referenced in the Parent Handbook.
